

Accessing the assessment

Your teacher will send you a link or an image for you to scan. Your teacher will show you how to use it. The link takes you to your assessment. Every new assessment has a different link.

Open the assessment by clicking on the link or scanning the image.



Click on the **Start** button to go to the first question.
