

## State Funding Opportunities Michigan

The **MI Kids Back on Track grant funds** (MCL388.1623g) will support programs provided before school, during school, after school, or during the summer. <u>These funds are designed to address unfinished learning</u>, get students to grade-level academic standards, provide additional academic assistance to students at risk of falling behind their peers.

## How ORIGO Aligns with the MI Kids Back on Track grant:

 ORIGO supports the implementation of MI Kids Back on Track grant funds by providing a variety of supplemental mathematics content that supports the goals of Common Core and other State standards and can be used as part of a high-impact tutoring program. ORIGO Education's supplementary learning resources are designed to support Tier 2 and Tier 3 intervention to help teachers and tutors develop students' mathematical understanding.



Michigan is one of 20 states selected by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services to receive **Preschool Development Grant – Birth through Five** (PDG B–5) renewal grant. PDG B–5 is a \$250-million competitive federal grant designed to improve states' early childhood landscape by building on existing federal, state, and local early care and learning investments.
