Preschool Expansion and Start-Up Funding: More than \$11.4 million recently allocated to 16 New Jersey school districts to create or expand their preschool programming during the 2022-2023 school year has enabled the addition of 1,081 full-day, high-quality preschool seats.

Legislation to watch: <u>Assembly Bill 165</u>: Establishes "New Jersey STEM Scholars Grant Pilot Program" in Department of Education.

This bill would establish a four-year "New Jersey STEM Scholars Grant Pilot Program," which would
provide grants to assist school districts in enhancing STEM education programs for students and
increasing access to STEM education programs. The program would provide competitive grants to
school districts for them to build upon existing STEM education programs or create new education
programs in three concentration areas: project-based learning, afterschool STEM, and out-of-school
STEM.
