

Buster the Balloon

A book about Comparing Two Objects

Aim

Buster the Balloon introduces size and length comparison words. Students explore concrete and pictorial representations of biggest, taller, wider, longer, fatter, and bigger. These whole-class/large group and small group activities provide students with the opportunity to:

- listen to a story about size or length comparison
- listen to the accompanying story tune
- use materials to explore size or length comparison
- use the teaching tool to compare size or length
- describe the size or length of objects in the environment using comparison words

Activities
