

The Cat Nap

A book about time on the hour

Aim

The Cat Nap introduces on-the-hour times by showing an analog clock face to follow a sequence of events.

These whole-class activities present students with the opportunity to:

- explore the relationship between the arms on an analog clock face
- listen to a story about the sequencing of on-the-hour events
- show on-the-hour times as depicted in a story
- use an analog clock to record on-the-hour events
- match clock faces with on-the-hour events and word cards
- order on-the-hour clock faces

Activities

2. Showing on-the-hour times
3. Observing and drawing clock faces
4. Using the teaching tool to show on-the-hour times
5. Recording on-the-hour times and events

8. Using the teaching tool to order on-the-hour times
